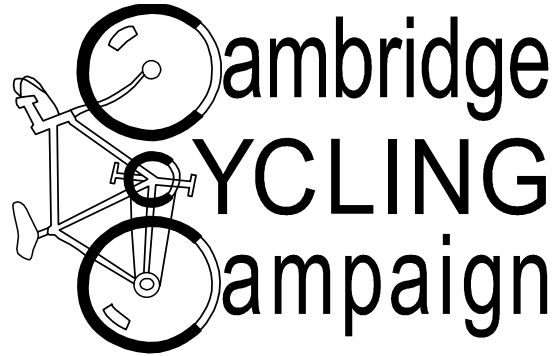

**Day nursery on land to the rear of Wolfson Court on Clarkson Road, Cambridge
(Council planning reference C/02/0315/FP)
(Planning inspectorate decision APP/Q0505/A/02/1104475)**

By way of introduction, Cambridge Cycling Campaign promotes cycling and the interests of cyclists in the Cambridge area. From its formation in 1995, Cambridge Cycling Campaign now has about 700 members, which means we are among the largest local cycling interest groups in the U.K.

We understand that there are plans for development on the above location, which runs near to a cycle route opened c. 1993 and developed subsequently, and that you, as Planning Inspector, will be making judgement on whether plans can proceed.

Cambridge Cycling Campaign does not have a view on the principle of a nursery or any other development on this site. However we believe the inspector should be aware of the importance of the cycle/pedestrian path that runs alongside the west side of the site between Clarkson Road and Madingley Road. In conjunction with the toucan crossing at its north end it offers a valuable route to the nearby University departments and between the Wilberforce/Clarkson Road area and the northern part of the City Centre via Madingley Road. Please ensure that no development is permitted which reduces the safety or convenience of this path.
