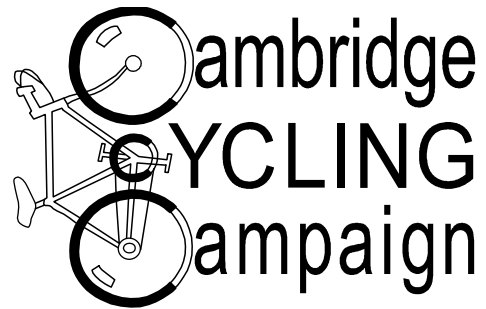

Improvements to cycle parking provision at Cambridge Railway Station

Further to our earlier involvement in this project, I write regarding its status at present.

We understand that confirmed funding had been found for the project, as a partnership between Cambridge City Council, WAGN and the Government's Cycle Projects Fund.

As you are no doubt aware, there is currently a considerable shortage of cycle parking, even after the provision of extra spaces a few years ago, representing considerable suppressed demand from present and potential customers. We therefore would welcome further cycle parking provision.

Unfortunately, it has been rumoured to us from various sources that the project, for which we understand the funding is still available, appears to have stalled, possibly temporarily, for whatever reason.

I am writing to enquire as to the status of the project, which we would have no hesitation in very actively welcoming, and to state that we would hope any problems which have arisen can be overcome quickly.
