### **Progress on Design Guide**

We write briefly to ask on the status of progress on the Design Guide. (In doing so, however, we reiterate our belief that it is important to get a good quality document, on which there should be as much consensus as possible, rather than produced a rushed version.)

Specifically, we would be interested to hear:

1. What work the County Council is now doing in response to the various suggestions made, including the desirability of reorganising the Guide to make a clear split between types of provision.
2. How the work by the City Council is progressing for their sections and amendments, if you are aware.

We thought you and your colleagues might be interested to know about the draft Essex Design Guide which we recently came across. It contains much interesting material and makes a very clear distinction between types of provision, strongly mirroring the 'hierarchy of provision' approach of Cycle Friendly Infrastructure.
