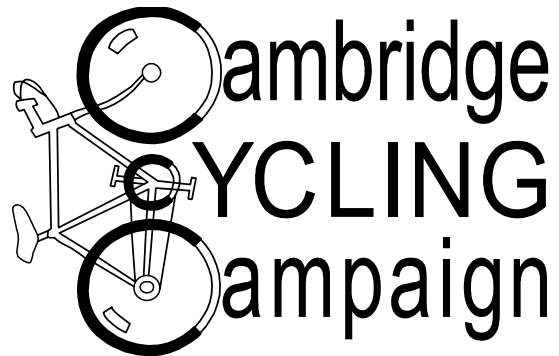

Access to the Beehive Centre by cyclists and pedestrians

We wrote on 27th April 2003 regarding the above; you kindly sent an acknowledgement by e-mail the following week, although I regret we have not heard from you since on the matters we raised.

I have enclosed a copy of our original letter for your convenience.

We are pleased to see that a few items appear to have been addressed, namely the speed humps (item 2), which now appear to have sufficient space for a cycle to pass, and secondly the addition of a reflector to the bollard noted in item 5, although we would maintain this bollard still causes a safety hazard to some degree.

We hope you will find time to address the remaining points we noted, all of which are simple, low-cost improvements which would make things considerably easier for your customers who access the site by bicycle. We would be happy to provide further detail on the items raised if required.

We look forward to hearing from you.
