**Trinity Street: contraflow provision for cyclists as requested by AJC**

We are writing to ask you what progress has been made on plans to introduce a contraflow for cyclists as decided by the Area Joint Committee. We regret we have not heard of any further information on progress on this matter since last August.

We would very much appreciate information on current Officer thinking about how the contraflow is intended to be implemented and an update on the proposed timetable for consultation on such plans.

We understand that Officers did have concerns as to how such provision could legally be signed. If such an issue remains, we would be interested to hear what contact has been made with Department for Transport Officials with regard to seeking special dispensation from the Secretary of State, should such an option be required and appropriate, given the special circumstances of this city centre location.
