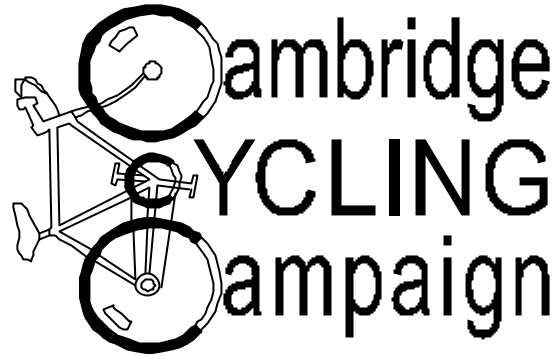

Dear Mr Preston,

Downing Street: red surfacing

We write to ask as to when red surfacing for the advanced stop line at the junction of Downing Street with St Andrew's Street will be completed. All other red surfacing has been applied, except for this advanced stop line, which also requires a cycle symbol.

We also request that advisory red surfacing be applied on Downing Street where it crosses Downing Place, as has been done with Tennis Court Road further along. Such surfacing would help inform emerging vehicles of the existence of a cycle contraflow and the likelihood that a cyclist will be using it.

Whilst we have concerns about the quality of surfacing being applied recently around the city, namely its bumpiness, we still feel it important that surfacing is applied here nonetheless.
