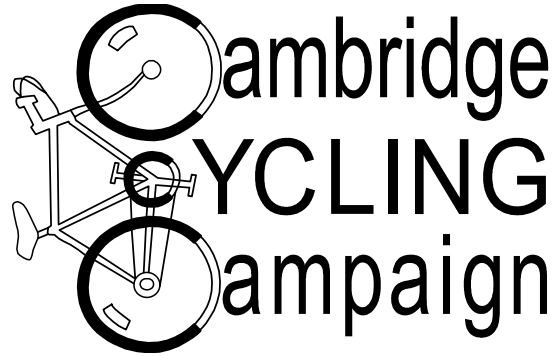

Dear Mark Kemp

**RE : Cycle Track on A603 bridge over M11**

Thank you for your letter MK/SK/PF37/June05. As you will understand we are keen to see this path reopened as soon as possible. To quote one of our members 'It really is appalling that such a facility can be left broken for this period of time.'

Since our last letter we have not seen any obvious progress. Please will you update us on the progress with this matter, specifically :-

- Did the County Council get funding from the Highways Agency for the repairs to the overbridge structure and has the site investigation and soil survey taken place?
- What repairs or improvements are necessary to safety fence?
- What are the minimum repairs that would have to be undertaken for the cycle path to be reopened?
- What are the next steps in progressing this matter?
- What is the expected date for re-opening of this cycle path?

If it looks like this path will be out of order for the foreseeable future we would like to see the current temporary barrier moved out 1.5m into the carriageway so that the temporary path can be used by people with bike trailers and so it is possible to pass oncoming cycles.
