Girton to Oakington road cycle path

We are writing to request a change to the current white lining.

At the moment the white lines lead you on a collision course with the bridge support. This is very difficult to see in the dark, especially with only cycle lights against oncoming motor vehicle headlights.

This is an accident waiting to happen.



We ask that the white lining be brought to the same standard as on the road namely :-

1. That a 5m stretch of diagonal hatching be painted before the obstacle, just as is common practice on the road (see right).
2. That reflective markings on the obstacle be added, just as is common practice on the road (see right).
