Cycle Parking Gresham Road

We are writing to ask for cycle parking to be provided on Gresham Road, at Fenners Physical Education Centre and Occupational Health Centre.

All available space in front of Fenners has been filled with cycle parking (though mostly of the insecure type that only holds your front wheel). During the evening rush there are between a dozen and 20 cycles that cannot fit into the existing racks because they are full.

These bikes are locked to the disabled ramp, bolted to lamp posts or just left on the pavement (unfortunately it is too dark to photograph the situation at its worst at this time of year)



We would like to see a rack of, say, 20 Sheffield stands (cycle racks like an inverted U) replace a short stretch of pavement and display on this road. This would encourage sustainable transport while helping to reduce the high rate of cycle theft we currently have in Cambridge.
