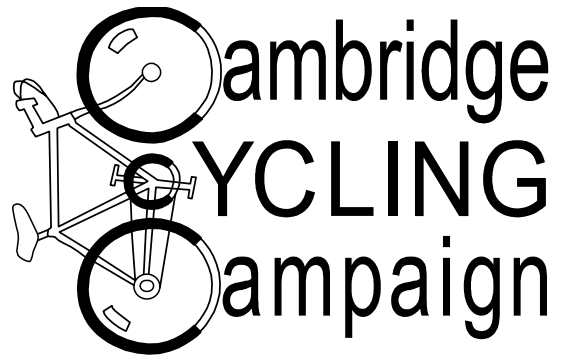

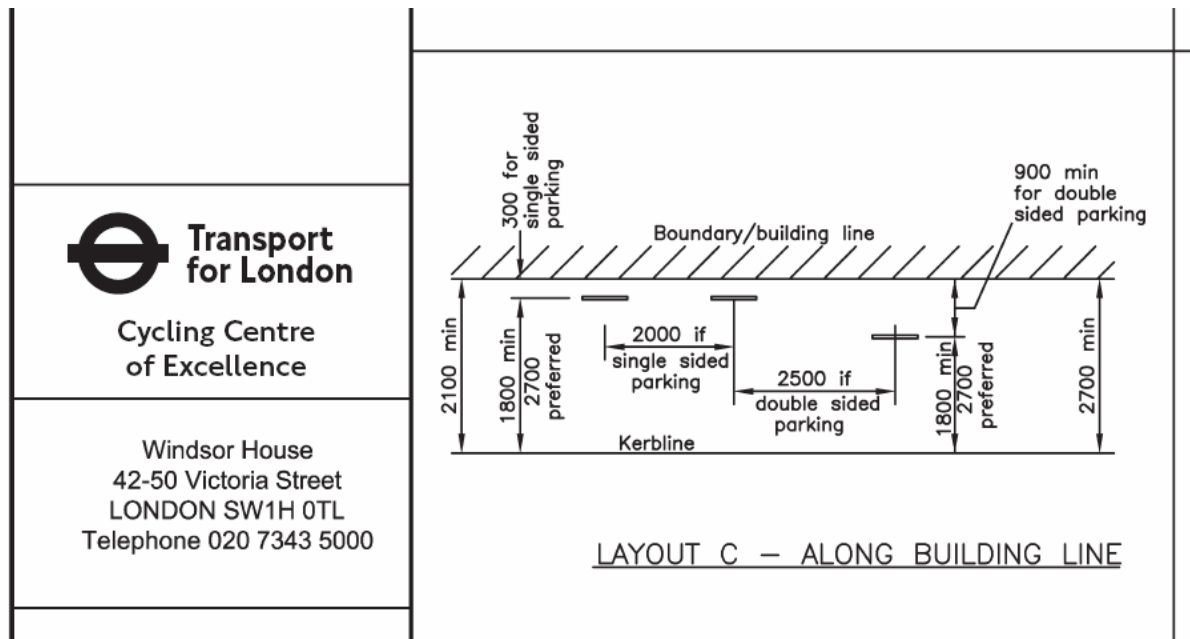

### **Cycle Parking Great Shelford**

We are writing to ask for cycle parking outside the Co-Op store in Great Shelford. The store is often used by commuting cyclists, but there is nowhere to secure bikes to. It is not possible to even keep an eye on your bike because the Co-Op has covered the window in adhesive advertising.



The pavement outside the Co-Op is 2.5m wide, much wider than the rest of the street. Transport for London's London Cycling Design Guide states that it is possible to erect cycle stands against a building edge provided the pavement is wider than 2.1m.



We would like to see 3 Sheffield stands against the shop frontage. This would encourage sustainable transport and support village shops while helping to reduce the high rate of cycle theft we currently have in Cambridgeshire.
