**Cambridge Sport Lakes Planning Application>**

Thank you for your letter of 12th April which I took to our recent Committee meeting.

The opinion at the meeting was that, although we welcome new opportunities for leisure cycling in and around Cambridge, we do not feel it would be appropriate for us to formally support the Cambridge Sports Lakes project, or indeed any other large planning application where the benefits to cycling are incidental.

Our main aim is to improve conditions for cycling as a means of transport into and within Cambridge.

With a project such as Cambridge Sports Lakes, there are many other factors to take into account, such as environmental concerns, on which we are not qualified to pass judgement and our members would not expect or want us to do so.

I am sorry not to be of help in this matter, but we will, of course, still take an interest in the outcome of your application and, should it go ahead, we would be happy to give our opinion on proposed cycle routes through the complex, especially as regards widths of paths, access points, etc. Our Campaign has much experience in matters of this sort and we have contributed to drafts of national guidelines.
