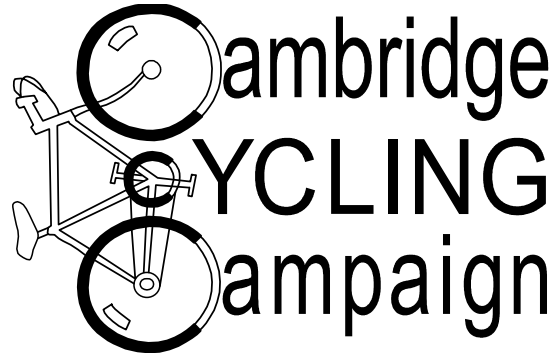

Park Street Cycle Park

Thanks to you and your colleagues for your time on Friday at what I thought was a productive meeting, which has resulted in a clear way forward. It is very clear to us that you have put much time into sorting out a lot of the problems we raised, and it is good to hear that the park is being targeted for promotion work and is attracting political support.

As we mentioned, we would be delighted to assist with the proposed promotion work, including distribution of the leaflet you mentioned with our Newsletter, and the sending of a positive press release from the Campaign about the facility.

As you were aware, we expressed reservations about the removal of the upright lockers but we shall consider that matter closed. It is clear that what users want are the horizontal lockers, and their heavy use will send a clear statement that there is demand, and thus a future call on funding. Do let us know when the new lockers are installed and in place.

It is also good to hear of the very positive "greening car parks" agenda being put forward by Cllr Reid.

Thanks again for your time and support on this. We shall ensure what are in general a positive set of proposals, particularly on clearing the entranceway, are reported positively in our Newsletter. Please do keep us updated on progress.
