### **Town and Country Planning General Regulations 1992 - Regulation 3**

**Proposal:** New pedestrian and cycle bridge across the River Cam, including access ramps, lighting, steps, paths to the public highway, landscaping, replacement of the jetty, and flood compensation areas.  
**Location:** Land between Ditton Walk and Fen Road, across Ditton Meadows and the River Cam, Cambridge  
**Application No:** C/5005/16/CC

Thank you for sending us your comments on the above planning application. I can confirm that they will be taken into account when a decision is made by the County Council's Planning Committee in due course. Once we have a precise date at which this application will be considered by our Planning Committee, I will write to you again to set out how you may register to speak.

On the basis that a number of the comments received in relation to this application actually relate to the wider Chisholm Trail, rather than just to this application, I thought that it would be useful to clarify the following to avoid any misunderstanding:

- (1) The Bridge application (C/5005/16/CC) will be determined by the County Council's Planning Committee as it is not a City Deal project and therefore does not fall within the terms of reference for the Joint Development Control Committee (JDCC). However, the Chisholm Trail is a City Deal Project which means that it will be determined by JDCC;
- (2) It is noted that a petition has been submitted to the City Council in relation to the Bridge application (C/5005/16/CC) to allow a Development Control Forum (DCF) meeting to take place ahead of JDCC, which is not relevant to the County Council's Planning Committee. Therefore whilst the information

contained within the petition will be considered when a decision is made by the County Council, a DCF will not take place. The lead petitioner will be contacted by the City Council to explain this further;

- (3) Comments made on the Bridge application (C/5005/16/CC) will only be considered in the determination of that application and will **not be** carried across to any other application, which includes the Chisholm Trail application. Therefore if you wish your points to be considered in relation to the Chisholm Trail application, these will need to be submitted before the close of the consultation period;
- (4) The consultation period for Chisholm Trail application (C/5007/16/CC) is due to close next Wednesday (28 September 2016). However, to ensure that there is time for you to consider whether you wish to also make representations in relation to the Chisholm Trail application following this update notification, we are prepared to extend the consultation period from 28 September 2016 until Friday 7 October 2016.

I hope that this clarifies the situation. However, if you have any further queries please do not hesitate to contact me.
