Local attractions say “come by bike in national Bike Week”

Cycling Campaign has arranged for free admission or reduced rates for people to visit local attractions during National Bike Week, which is next week, June 6 - 14 - provided, of course, they arrive by bike.

Campaigner David Earl said: “we are delighted so many places are welcoming cyclists in this way. And of course, the cycle ride is all part of the day out. We hope this will encourage more people to get on their bikes during the week.”

Details of the 16 participating venues are shown in the attached table. Cambridge Cycling Campaign can offer advice on how to get to the places listed on (01223) 504095. In some cases taking bikes part way on the train would be the best way to go.

National Bike Week also sees a series of events organised by the Campaign including on Sunday afternoon in Cambridge Market Square “Try a bike” to have a go on some more unusual cycles; and on Wednesday morning at Hobbs Pavilion restaurant on Parker’s Piece, a free cyclists’ breakfast on “Bike To Work day”.

Cambridge Cycling Campaign was formed during National Bike Week, 1995 and now has almost 500 members in and around the City.
